Left Banda II "somewhere about. and reached medje between shire and fores o' clock. For some distance along the road were fresh elephant and buffalo tricks. a flock of six male green pursqueto, like we collected at Sumangui was sun flying by, giving their conterminous finch like notes A drongo shrike (we have sen bit one specs theirs far) woo observed pecking at a large cicada, which it afforentty held under one foot when mot actively engaged. This cicada its very common in the forest,
and is lennon to the Mangletre as "nyi-nye"-nye", while they imitate its say fairly cruel, as foll ur
