april 8, 1910 (Friday) Left Banda comewhere about. noon, and reached medge between three and four o'clock. For some distance along the road were fresh elephant and buffalo tracks a flock of six small green paragrets, like we collected at Samangie, was seen flying by, giving their continuous finch like notes a drongo shrike (we have seen but one species their far) was observed freking at a large creada, which it apparently held under one foot when not actually engaged. This cicada is very common in the forest. and is known to the mangletu as "nye-nye-nye, while they instate its song fairly well, as follows

nyi nyi nyi nyi nya nya nyayayaga a a a a .- - - f three or form species were very common all the way up to medge, and lots of mullipedes (all of the same species) were also noticed In one place, a couple of hundred, at least, were walking about in a space some 2 or 3 yards in diameter. about 10 weavers, from brown backed specus, was observed; the first I have seen for a long time perhaps since leaving m'sayre. "fresterals " rutas seen


crossing the road in a damp portion, and three small brown backed ligards defied all my efforts to capture When we arrived at the post, a lite, of course was a couple of rollers, were giving their harsh radack, nadach, nadach-h-h-h. april 9, 1910. Saturday medie spent day packing my things for the trip to avaluable, mr. Boyton leaves the day after tomorrow. Early this morning in the open place near the mess


a pratincole was feeding, and would allow one to approach controlling with some send cline thirty feet aff april 10, 1910 (Sunday) medie to Banda, Hamto 3 pm. not many had seen, but principally because I did not look for them almost the whole way so frest, with plenty of streams - 24 bridges, I believe - which mr Vergrupsen ("mambrite) has just been renewing. at Bandache has als built a new gite d step. In front of this house stands a high tree with a small colony of black

weavers (the species with q greenish) meeting in it. flycatchers were heard, a flock of 25 1130 Riparias was observed, and a number of the lettle black swallows with white under wing. coverts and deeply forked at I bambi I found mo Buyon, who came up the Congo in the same steamer with us. Here there was another bite, a yellow-breasted wagter, and some large brown rumped

pivallows.

yesterday and today comparatively few tiger beetles were to be seen on the road; but there were some of the same millipide noted on apr. 8. One large nepa was found in a puddle Shis morning a blackand white willtare was observed at Banda, and 40x 5 Chrysococyx smaragdineus were heard along the way.
